


# Primary Long Term Planning (Sept 2015 Update)

Themes to include;	Learn about which animals live at Farms, Zoos, Aquariums and as Pets. Animal Lifecycles. Create art inspired by the patterns and textures of animal prints.	Label and experience different types of weather. Learn about appropriate clothing for different weather conditions. Plant lifecycles. Create art and music inspired by colours and seasons.	Learn about the seaside and countryside. Experience different types of holidays and holiday activities, for example, camping, playing at the beach, skiing and swimming.
Year 2	<b>Me, My Family and Homes</b>	<b>Transport and Journeys</b>	<b>Earth and Space</b>
Themes to include;	Label body parts and the senses. Label family members. Trips to homes. Learn about the different types of homes. Learn about the different types of rooms in home and the associated activities, for example, cooking in the kitchen, washing in the bathroom.	Label vehicles. Experience different forms of transport. Experience imaginary journeys, for example, to magical lands or underwater. Journeys back and forward in time.	Learn about our planet and others planets. Label planets, stars, moon and the sun. Experience the awe and wonder of space. Create art and music inspired by earth and space, for example, rockets and moonscapes
Year 3	<b>Fairy-tales and Stories</b>	<b>Our School and Local Community</b>	<b>People and Places of the World</b>
Themes to include;	Listen to different stories and fairy-tales. Create art inspired by stories and fairy-tales. Experience the different characters from stories and fairy-tales. Learn about story structure.	Explore the school, including who works at school and their roles. Experience trips to local places, for example, shops, library and community buildings. Explore the contrast between villages, towns and cities Learn to recognise people from the emergency services and what they do.	Experience the cultures of different places, for example, music, dance, festivals and foods. Learn about maps and globes. Explore the contrast of different countries and continents.
