- Staff breaks on outings **Comment from Summer Club Manager:** Unfortunately we cannot always safely manage breaks on certain outings, and staff are required to remain with the students and eat their lunches together etc. Where ever possible we always give staff breaks but hopefully the high rate of pay is fair compensation when this is not possible.
- During morning drop off could children go in the hall with music or games as it can get manic with parents, children + staff. Also if we are out having lunch, please make sure kids have a table to sit at to eat. When we went to aeroplanes in Blackbushe most of the staff sat around the table to eat their lunch which left no room for students to eat off their knees. Not perfect especially for the students like **(student names removed)** that need a table. **Comment from Summer Club Manager:** This is a very fair point, when preparing for morning outings we were all in the hub area and it did get noisy/busy at times. We can certainly try this next year. Thank you.
- Fun day (last day) maybe parents come in a bit later not all day
- More info on children **Comment from Summer Club Manager:** we have explored the possibility of having student passports at summer club however I sadly do not have a lot of prep time ahead of summer club, being classed based in the day and having to run ASC. If we are unable to provide these, as always, I urge staff to ask for advice on children they are less familiar with as there is always other members of staff present who know the children well.
