40 questionnaires were sent out, 17 were returned (42.5% return rate). This was an improvement on last year when 19 of 54 (35.2%) questionnaires were returned. **Please note: all comments have been anonymised by removing student names.**

Analysis: Large decrease from previous year at (100%). This could be because in previous years all days were open to all students whereas this year we had to split groups under our covid-19 guidelines. The question technically means whether a parent felt that their child would be able to fully participate in any of the activities on offer to them, so perhaps this question needs to be rephrased for future years to ensure responses are understood clearly. 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Analysis: Increase from previous year (94.7%). It should be noted that this is the first year in a long time that we received 100% on this question. This may be due to the trial of handwritten feedback forms (akin to home-school diaries) and also that we have had to take children out to their parents at the end of the day rather than letting parents inside the building, which perhaps gave us more time to talk about their day. This might be worth continuing with even when covid-19 guidelines are not in operation.
