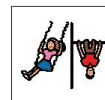

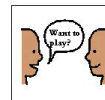

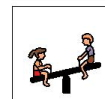
Playing



Sometimes I like to play with other kids.



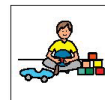
I can ask them, "Do you want to play with me?"
